A. God calls us to His Mission - He created us for this!

Joshua is part of the continuing story of God's unfolding STORY. See Dt 1:20-46

- God's plan was to deliver us from bondage to sin (Red Sea) and into our inheritance and God's mission(Jordan)
- Promises of God unfolded for Old Covenant people for over 400 years, we can rest assured that God will make good on His promises fulfilled in Jesus
  - Old Covenant Failure: God brought people to land Dt 1:21
  - People rebelled wouldn't go up Dt 1:26
  - Moses encouraged people to remember God's faithfulness; rejected Dt 1:29-32
  - God judged that generation for unbelief: Dt 35-36
  - People attempted on their own and failed Dt 1:43-44
- God will always lead His people and He expects us to follow Him and trust Him <a href="Apply Today">Apply Today</a>: What is our mission that God calls us to today (New Covenant)?   - God gives us New Covenant signs
