  - Gal 3:15-17 God's covenant promise to Abram
  - Moses' law introduced 430 years later doesn't change promises
  - True recipient of God's promise was Abraham's offspring: Jesus
  - Jesus is the true beneficiary of all God's promises! Christ gets it all!
  - So every good thing we seek is to be found in Christ Gal 3:20 2 Cor 1:20: 2 Tim 1:9-10
- Paul asks, "Why then the Law?" Gal 3:19
  - Law was added because of transgressions until Christ came
  - If we were obedient and holy we wouldn't need the Law
  - Law also exposes Sin reveals insidious nature of our sin
  - Law was only a quardian 24 until Christ came
  - Don't be like Judiazers missed purpose of God's Law
  - Don't misuse: Fire good in fireplace, bad on carpet.
- Paul asks, "Is Law contrary to God's promises?" NO!
