- Great Exchange – 2 Cor 5:21

### The Gospel - A Comfort & A Call

- There are 2 COMFORTS of the Gospel:
  - Gospel removes the Condemnation of Sin Rm 8:1-3
  - Gospel removes the Guilt of Sin Rm 8:4-5
  - God gives us His Holy Spirit so we can now walk in holiness Rm 8:4-5
- The Gospel does MORE than just REDEEM us!
  - With the enabling of the Holy Spirit comes the CALL! Rm 8:12-15
  - A call to live as becomes a son of God & be His ambassador!
  - Many talk about the comfort of the Gospel without remember the Call – but this denies passages like Titus 2:11-14
