Jesus' School of the Kingdom

- Jesus wanted time to teach the disciples privately³⁰⁻³¹
- Teaching background: 8:31,32,34;9:2,14 about kingdom

The Hard Reality of the Gospel

- Jesus taught about His suffering, death & resurrection³¹
- Jesus is clear about His purpose
- Teaching us how bad sin is & how great God's grace is!
- Sin is not just behavior but a matter of our hearts^{Mk7:20-23}
- Jesus' work was necessary so God's righteousness was not compromised in redeeming us!
- NEVER forget the hard reality of the Gospel our hideous sin requires the grace of the Cross of Jesus!

A Really Sad Comment 32

- The disciples didn't get it yet...
- The Gospel is bad news before it becomes good news!
- The plan was in God/Jesus' control^{Jn10:17-18}

A Separated Conversation

- · Because they didn't understand, disciples separated...
- So they had argument over who was the greatest!
- Sin causes us to forget why we were created (for God)
- Jesus came that we might live for Jesus' glory^{2Cor5:15}

A Gracious and Compassionate Jesus

- Disciples didn't want to answer Jesus³³
- Jesus addressing disciple's attitude toward greatness³⁵
- Greatness=an attitude of the heart
- Jesus' life was that of a servant^{Mk10:45}not Creator
- This reinforces what Jesus taught^{Mk8:35}
- Do you live with this attitude of Gospel greatness?

Scripture Examples

- Put Offs/Ons of Scripture Eph 4; Col 3
- Paul demonstrates w/ communication: Eph 4:29
 - not a focus on vocabulary, but on intent/meaning
 - This is how we live for greatness glory of God!
- Jesus uses powerless child as an example
- Power of the Gospel>look in faith to God's Grace as you die to self and live for His glory & know peace!
