- Jews could have convicted on blasphemy and stone, but then they couldn't pass the buck to the Romans
- Tried to use temple destruction angle because Romans wanted peace at all costs

A Ouestion Posed in Frustration 60-62

- Caiaphas appears frustrated... Jesus didn't play his game
- They had wrestled with question of was Jesus the Messiah
- Did Judas share what Jesus had told the apostles? After Parable of Tenants they were angry^{Mk12:12}
- Jesus answer plainly declares He is the Christ! Dan7:13-14;Psa110:1
- Who is on trial? Jesus or the leaders & Israel?
- The decision was made^{Mk15:1}
