### **The Darkness**

- darkness @ mid-day 12-3.
- Not an eclipse, not possible at Passover, eclipses 7 ½ min
- darkness was God's judgment
- Darkness before 1<sup>st</sup> Passover: Ex 10:21-23 3 days
- Fulfills Amos 8:9
- God's signal He is about to judge sinners...
- Beware another darkness is coming Rev 16:10-11
- Avoid it by faith through faith in Christ Rev 19:9

# The Ultimate Cry of Anguish

- v34 ultimate cry of anguish
- Curse of the Covenant coming to bear: God cut in two!
- Luther: "God forsaken of God! Who can understand it?"
- Jesus was holy, perfect who had to bear our icky sin
- Jesus descended into hell abandoned by God
- Because of Jesus, believers will never be abandoned Heb13:5-6

## The Responses 35-39

- 'religious Jews' thought Jesus calling for Elijah (superstitious)
- Roman centurion saw something different in Jesus
- The Women bravely remained w/ Jesus, later annoint body

- v37 Jesus breathed His last!
- Not in subjection to some fate, but as an act of obedience
- Jesus gave His life<sup>Jn19:30</sup> as a ransom<sup>Mk10:45</sup>
