- Probably not Paul even though KJV suggests that
- Author heard from apostles^{2:3}; Paul from Jesus^{Gal 1:11-12}
- Style doesn't fit Paul
- Most likely a series of Sermons combined into a book

- They were trying to 'go back', forgetting Christ is superior
- Likely written before destruction of temple AD70^{Heb8:13}
- Some no longer studying God's Word^{5:12-14}
- Some neglecting faithfulness in weekly worship Heb10:24-25
- Like ancestors forgetting God's goodness & grace

- Material wealth, it won't satisfy like peace with God
- Relationships, Only Jesus promises to never leave you Heb13:5
- Sexual Freedom or Own identity. Jesus' true love 1015:13
- Comfort & Ease. Because of Jesus we are willing to give up material things^{Lk17:33}
