Intro:

- Theme of Hebrews: Jesus is Better!
- "The House that Ruth Built" - Yankee Stadium, Babe Ruth great!
- Moses was great in eyes of Jews
- Moses - humble^{Nu12:3}; faithful^{Num12:7}; used greatly by God

Both Moses & Jesus were Faithful Men 2

- Pastor builds off Moses, Jews thought highly of Moses^{Num12:6-7}
- Jesus was the most faithful of men - w/o sin^{Heb4:15}

Jesus is Worthy of More Glory than Moses 3-4

- Moses was merely a member of God's house
- BUT Jesus was the builder of God's house & everything!
- Jesus planned it all^{1Co10:1-4}

Moses was just a Servant, Jesus was a Son! 5-6

- Moses was a great servant of God
- Jesus was the Son of God!
- Moses was but a messenger - testify^{Jn5:46}

Beware of Turning Back

- Many were tempted to abandon Jesus & turn back to Moses
- But there is no comparison between Jesus & Moses
- Jesus is in a category by Himself as He is God!

Consider Jesus!

- Think deeply; take time to observe...
- Jesus exhorted us to consider the ravens^{Lk12:24} and lillies^{Lk12:27}
- While Moses was great, Jesus is way better!

Do YOU take time to Consider Jesus in your Life?

- Beware of letting the little things overwhelm you...
- Beware of making up a Jesus of your liking... WLC 109
- Know the Jesus of the Bible, not of culture or movies...
- Jesus redeemed you to make you a Holy Brother!
- Consider Jesus^{Jn3:17} as an apostle (sent one)...
- He fulfilled the Triune God's purpose perfectly!
- Consider Jesus as our High Priest... makes us acceptable to God's Holiness!

So What?

- As great as Babe Ruth was, he was just a baseball player...
- BUT Jesus is in a category of One, the only God-Man, the only builder of God's house, the Word of God incarnate!
- Are YOU in His house⁶?
- We can be part of His house by faith alone in His redeeming work on our behalf:

Heb 4:16—Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
