2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 1:1-14 "THE 3 P 'S OF SECOND PETER" God's Peace, Power and Promises

**INTRODUCTION**: Peter was first of the apostles, a member of Jesus inner circle.

2<sup>nd</sup> Peter is like his last will and testament to the Church.

Main theme: Make sure you are grounded in the faith, so you won't fall away.

**V.1** Peter is a servant of Christ, and this book has apostolic authority.

## Those that have obtained like precious faith with us.

Do you wish you had lived in Jesus' day, to have seen the miracles?

Precious faith, rich, costly, valuable.

Rom.10:17 "faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God."

**Righteousness of God**: God gives faith to all sorts of people, Jew and Gentile, old and young, male and female,

Notice that Peter calls Jesus God, "The God of us and Savior Jesus Christ."

## I. **PEACE** V.2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you.

Peter is at peace. To know Christ is to know peace.

Sin is forgivable, You can be at peace!

What do you worry about? What do you lose sleep over?

Through the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord

Peace comes through the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord."

## II. **POWER** V. 3 **Divine Power**

Peter speaks of this divine power (1:16-18)

V. 4 and 2:18,20 God's POWER can help you to "escape."

God's power is given to us for all things pertaining to life and godliness".

## III. PROMISES 1:4 Exceedingly great and precious promises.

Precious" costly, of great price, Exceedingly great, big and large in number

- **3:13** One "**promise**" Peter specifically mentions here is where God promises us new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.
- **1:4** "That through these you may be partakers of the divine nature having escaped the depravity that is in the world".

**CONCLUSION**: When God saves us, He gives us His Peace, His Power, and His Promises to change us and keep us faithful to the end.
