From Ichabod to Immanuel

Review:

- Israel learned what happened when they take God lightly
- God doesn't demand our performance or antics but asks only that we look to Him in faith alone for our protection and salvation.

That's NOT Good News: 12

- Runner ~21miles
- Eli was waiting & trembling¹³ seems concerned over ark
- Eli knew fate of sons, unnamed man^{2:33-34}; Samuel^{3:13}
- Eli knew his son's disobedience had imperiled ark
- Eli knew Israel had not sought God's quidanceDt12
- If you want favor and peace don't disobey God's Word^{Jn14:6}

Eli Receives News: 15-18

- News of ark's capture was devastating to Eli¹⁸
- Eli's sins & son's sins now imperiled God's people
- Wordplay: heavy¹⁸ vs. glory²² departed the glory^{KBD} has departed and is now heavy^{KBD} around Eli's waist
- Eli didn't stop the wandering of people from God Jdg2:10-12
- Eli enjoyed fruits of son's corruption (fat)
- What do you owe God? Romans 12:1-2 your life1Cor6:20

Things Don't Look So Good 19-22

- Phinehas' wife goes into labor suddenly upon news¹⁹
- Storyteller mentions pains of birth reminding us...
- Widow saw implications of God removing presence: Ichabod
- Let us not cry Ichabod today Rom 10:5-9
- We have God as near as His Word Rom10:8!

But What About the Ark & God's Discipline?

- 30K slaughtered, ark is gone, God's discipline is heavy... God had given great promises^{Ex6:7} God is a covenant keeper! Believers have similar promises^{Heb13:5; Rom8:38-39} today^{Jn10:28}
- Don't look at circumstances or feelings but Word^{Rom10:9}!

When the Glory Departs

- They regarded God lightly... consequences, discipline... Later^{Eze10:18-19} God disciplined after much idolatry^{Babylon exile} NT churches^{Rev2-3} warned^{study & avoid their sins}! WCF 18:4
- God won't tolerate continual disobedience to Word Is29:13; Jer2:7,11
- Situation at Shiloh is a warning Jer7:14

From Ichabod to Immanuel

- What to do when 'Ichabod'? Zec 1:3; Ex 34:6
- Call upon God in obedience for mercy: Jer 29:12-14
- OT worst Ichabod: fall of Jerusalem 586
- History worst Ichabod: John 1:1-5,9-11
- Glory of God dwelt among mankind but rejected but rejecte
- Men crucified Jesus, darkness over the land Mt27:45
- BUT God! Jesus rose on 3rd day^{Jn20:31}
- Your sin cries 'Ichabod'; God's grace cries 'Immanuel'!
- Let us be messengers crying God's Gospel^{Isa52:7}
