# A Contrast of Leaders

- Finding good leaders can be tough
- Israelites chose leaders who didn't know God's Word<sup>154:3</sup>, defeated Samuel was raised up by God<sup>153:20;4:1-2</sup> spoke God's Word
- People chose not to listen to God but chose their own ways<sup>1Sam4:3</sup>

### **Results of Not Listening to God:**

- Paraded ark out as lucky charm<sup>1S4:10-11</sup>, defeat, ark lost
- Philistines think they 'captured' God, bad results<sup>156:1-16</sup> •
- Beth-shemeshites wrongly handle God's glory, send away6:21 .
- We must deal with God according to His Word .

# A Big Pause - the importance of Repentance

- A long time passed<sup>157:2</sup> 20 years
- Last saw Samuel faithfully preaching God's Word<sup>154:1</sup> .
- Now a whole generation later... Lamenting after the Lord •
- Samuel called for repentance, God's word was effective Isa55:11 •
- Repent, turn from other gods, serve God alone<sup>Jms2:18-26</sup> .
- God's word shows us His holiness, people responded<sup>7:4-6</sup> Pouring of water=deep repentance<sup>Ps22:14;Lam2:19;Ps62:8</sup> •
- .
- Hannah used that image of pouring in her praver<sup>1S1:15</sup>

# The importance of God's Word

- Samuel judges people by declaring God's Word •
- Foreshadows Jesus Christ<sup>Heb7:25</sup> Word judges & calls to faith •
- Jesus is our advocate before the Father<sup>1Jn2:1</sup>

#### The First Bia Test

- People returned to God & repented; world responds7:7 •
- This is a faith test: will they trust God or their own methods? •
- The Philistines have been oppressing Israelites<sup>7:2;13:19</sup> •
- Will they use God like last time<sup>154:4</sup>? .
- Will they fail to revere God again<sup>156:19</sup>? •
- This is a Big Faith test for God's people<sup>157:3</sup>
- Will they trust God or do what is familiar and appealing? •
- Many today try to come to God on their terms, not by Word .

# The People Turn to God Crying Out for Mercy The people cry out through Samuel for mercy<sup>7:8</sup>

- They turned from other gods (repentance) •
- They now turn in faith to God alone for deliverance •
- Victory is secured by prayer<sup>7:10</sup> •
- The Lord thundered, Philistines defeated •
- God delivers His people as we have faith in His provision! .
- We must repent (turn from our sin) and believe in God<sup>Mark1:15</sup> •
- Rest in God's provision alone, not bravado or self •
- Gospel is quietly resting in God's provision<sup>Isa30:15</sup> .
