#### A Sad Summary

- Last week summary of Saul's life 1 Sam 14:47-52
- Saul's life defined by fighting the enemies of the world
- What would his life have looked like if Saul had been obedient?

#### Saul Called to Holy War

- Saul called to obey God<sup>15:1-3</sup> to judge the Amalekites
- Not revenge, but judgment for sin •
- Amalek attacked Israelites<sup>Ex17:8</sup> after crossing Red Sea<sup>Ex14</sup> .
- After that battle God declared I will utterly blot out Ex17:14-16 .
- Not genocide. Foretaste of what is to come<sup>Rev19:14-21</sup>
- God is holy and just<sup>2Peter3:9-10</sup> He will judge .
- Judgment came for the Amalekites, it will for vou<sup>Acts17:30-31</sup>

### Saul Goes to Battle

- Saul seems to respond in obedience<sup>15:4-5</sup>
- Shows kindness to Kenites<sup>15:6;Ex18:10,19</sup>

### Saul Does It His Wav

- Saul defeated the Amalekites<sup>7</sup> good!
- But, took king alive<sup>8</sup> and kept the good stuff<sup>9</sup>

### God Communicates with Samuel

- God told Samuel '*I regret that I have made Saul king*'<sup>11</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> time failure for Saul<sup>13:10;15:9</sup>

# Understanding God's Character: Did He Change His Mind?

- How can God be said to regret or repent if He is unchanging? .
- Isaiah<sup>46:9-10</sup> declares God is sovereign, all-knowing •
- God has ordained history Eph1:11 .
- God is not a man and so His regret is not like our regret ٠
- God appointed Saul knowing he would disobey and rebel
- Who changed in this narrative? Saul did, not God .
- Saul changed, not God therefore God in relationship . responded consistent with His character to Saul
- Not just "anthropopathism" attribute human feelings to a divine being so we understand.
- God does 'regret' when responding to man's sin Gen6:5-6
- God responds consistent with His character He always responds in mercy to those who repent<sup>Jonah3:10</sup> .
- That should give us GREAT COMFORT, God is not capricious
- God is consistent & faithful! .
- God is the Glory of His People<sup>15:29</sup> •
- God shows mercy to all those who repent because of His character<sup>Psa86:5</sup> and His promises!

# Not A Word is Wasted<sup>Isa55:11</sup>

- Saul's story recorded to teach us and warn us
- Saul called to lead and guide people in obedience .
- Saul chose his own way .
- With Jesus God not only regretted sin, He bore sin<sup>1Pet1:3-7</sup> ٠
- God's character is to redeem His people for His glory so we now get to obey!
