- A mere 20 words remember it really is God's story, not ours!

# An Odd Couple

- man described: rich, heavy, not nice then name given Nabal=fool
- Abigail<sup>my divine father is joy</sup>; discerning & beautiful like Esther<sup>2:7</sup>, Rachel<sup>Gen29:17</sup>
- They are truly an Odd Couple
- Note Abigail is described much like David 15am 16:12,18

#### A Rich Fool & His Actions

- It is sheep shearing time time of celebration & settling accounts
- David & men had helped & protected Nabal & shepherds 15a25:15-16
- David has needs 600 men
- ANE hospitality was not an option, David was gracious in approach
- Illus: Contrast Confederate Army of N.VA vs Union Army of TN one respected property; while other left scars a 100yrs later!
  - David showed himself to be a good king protection, care
- So David should have been rewarded for his service
- Nabal was a fool in response insulting & belligerent
- Nabal was a fool<sup>Ps14:1</sup>; self-centered<sup>11</sup> didn't see God's hand Nabal was miserly<sup>Pr11:24,28</sup> and trusted in his own riches
- David didn't take this answer very well strapped on swords 3x<sup>13</sup>

## Why Did David Respond this Way?

- David was not on guard from this attack -unexpected:Peter Jn18:10,17
- David's failure was after a great victory he had just spared Saul, wasn't dependent upon God's grace & quidance. Paul<sup>2Cor12:10</sup>
- David's failure reminds us it is not about us. All for Jesus 1Pet2:21-23

## A Godly Woman - Abigail

- An unnamed servant saves the day goes to Abigail, not Nabal 14-17
- Abigail had it hard with Nabal could have used opportunity
- Abigail made haste<sup>18</sup> to protect her husband & family
- Used Jacob's trick of sending good stuff ahead
- Didn't inform husband, avoided quarrel and solved problem
- David is still very mad<sup>21-21</sup>; KJV course description of men
- Abigail comes graciously and humbly to David
  - 1- Abigail humbled herself treated David as superior
  - 2- A took the blame quickly didn't push blame on David
  - 3- A offers restitution<sup>27</sup> and honors David publicly<sup>28</sup>
  - 4- A asks for forgiveness<sup>28</sup> points to God's grace
  - Abigail's Appeals:
    - 1- to not respond in kind<sup>25-26</sup>. Repay evil w/good<sup>Rom12:17-21</sup>
    - 2- to God's grace 'sling' to remind David of God's grace
    - 3- remind David he is God's servant<sup>28</sup> act accordingly

### The Gospel According to Abigail

- to whom will David go now that Samuel is dead? God gave Abigail!
- Like Abigail Jesus came to us in a humble way Like Abigail Jesus took guilt upon himself 1Pet2:24
- Like Abigail Jesus gave what we needed perfect obedience<sup>Rm5:19</sup>
- Abigail appealed for forgiveness based upon God's grace and called for holy actions 1Thes4:3
