A Non-chronological Chapter

- David was in pickle with Philistines... and the story is interrupted! •
- True chronological order: 1) 27:1-28:2 2) 29:1-11 3) 28:3-25 •
- We can guess that due to geography^{28:4;29:1} given to us
- Narrator wants us to see Saul's problem way worse than David's

Life's Burdens seem lighter when viewed from God's context

- Cliche: "there's always somebody worse off that you" not helpful
- We must view our trials in light of God's sovereignty
- Jesus to invalid for 38yrs 'that nothing worse may happen "In5:5,14
- The far worse is separation from God^{28:15}
- In Jesus we rightly fear God & have hope Psa66:16-20 .

Most hopeless misery in all of life is to be abandoned by God

- Samuel died, Saul had no voice to listen to
- Saul facing massive Philistine aggression, very afraid⁵ •
- God was no longer listening to or guiding Saul Saul tried⁶ •
- But Saul's heart wasn't right and wouldn't call on God humbly Joel2:23 •
- Chronicler shows us Saul's heart^{1Chr10:13-14}
- Other wicked kings repented Ahab^{1K21:29}; Manasseh^{2Chr33:12-13}
- Saul seems determined to come to God on his own terms •
- Will you come to God humbly through Jesus Christ^{Jn14:6} .

Unbiblical Methods Won't Reach God

- Saul decides forbidden ways^{Dt18:9-14} to seek out counsel from God
- Saul's own orthopraxy³ made that harder •
- Saul removes his royal robes & disguises self⁸ .
- Saul even swears by Yahweh no harm to medium¹⁰ .
- Medium shocked by Samuel's appearance knew it was Saul
- Samuel appeared by God's purposes descriptive not prescriptive!
- Samuel's message from God is the same: you did not obey¹⁸ •
- If we despise God's Word, He will take it from us! •

Spiritual Desperation Can Be Misdirected

- Saul could have humbled himself & sought God but he didn't¹⁶
- Saul wanted results of God's favor, not God's favor •
- What is difference between believer and Saul feeling forsaken? •
- Ps 13¹⁻⁴ David felt forsaken he ran to God^{Ps13:3}, not other things •
- David didn't look elsewhere he pushed into God^{Ps139:23-24} .
- We now live in the Gospel Age! We have Jesus as advocate^{1Jn2:1-2}
- Jesus is our Great High Priest^{Heb4:14-16} trust in HIS work not yours
- Remember Double Cure of the Gospel:
 - 1) Jesus paid for our Sins^{Rom5:8}
 - 2) By faith we get His perfect Righteousness^{Rom3:22}

Even in Darkness, the Light of the Gospel Shines

- Saul was terrified when he realized reality of his actions²⁰ .
- Medium set 'last supper' before Saul before he went into night^{dark} •
- Judas also received 'morsel' before going out into night^{Jn13:3} Jesus went into darkness^{Mk15:33-34} so we don't have to •
- Jesus' cry meant we don't have to face darkness^{Rom3:22}
